  - We have completed the June 4th & 5th Yard Sale. All leftover items will be donated to the Food Pantry for their next sale. Majority felt we should have two Yard Sale so next time we do Spring and Fall. The Sherman News Channel 10 showed up and interviewed Olivia Hutchison and other Yard Sale participants. The sale was advertised in Grayson County Shopper, Leader, Nextdoor app, and Whitewright Sun. Email blasts were sent out weekly including this event. We need to establish our dates for all our events earlier in the year. In the future Yard Sale maps need to be added to the website. We cleaned out the storage area and items were put in the sale here on site, we collected \$138. We need to team up with the Food Pantry and have a Yard Sale in the Fall, follow up with Sarah-Beth on a date.
  - The Tractor Pull is coming up, 45<sup>th</sup> event – this is not a Chamber event but a big event for the city. Volunteers are needed at the entry gate if anyone is interested.
  - Golf tournament will be on Monday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at Tanglewood. We will have a drink cart and with food served in boxes. Letters need to go out to our sponsors for T-Signs and follow-up calls need to be made. Website can be used to make payments for sponsorships and entry fees. Trophies will be handled by Ashley Schoonover who will also donate (100) goodie canvas bags from Farmers Insurance. Angie will make tournament registration form. Olivia to check on registration form being added to website.
